





## INTERNATIONAL VETERANS TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT COSTA DAURADA

### Welcome Pack and Accreditation Pickup

Participants can collect their accreditation and Welcome Pack during the first two days of the championship at the entrance of the sports hall.

All players must check in at the Accreditation Pickup on October 29, either in the morning or in the afternoon, to confirm their attendance.

Players whose first matches are scheduled for the morning of October 30 must check in at the Accreditation Pickup as soon as they arrive at the sports hall if they were not able to do so on October 29.

# Warm-up Session Ennis

A warm-up session will be available on October 29th, from 10:00 to 13:00 in the playing hall.

During match days, all tables will be available for warm-up during the hour before the start of the matches.

Once the competition begins, two tables will remain available for warm-up during playing hours.

The sports hall will open one hour before the start of the first match each day.


Please note: The playing hall will be closed on the afternoon of October 31st when no matches are scheduled.

### **Welcome Cocktail**

The Welcome Cocktail will take place on October 29, starting at 20:00, on the terrace of Hotel Olympus Palace, located at Av. Navarra 6, 43840 Salou.

Attendance is completely free for all players, while guests or accompanying persons pay €10.

Tickets can be purchased throughout the day at the playing hall or directly at the entrance to the cocktail.





### Official Accommodation

The official hotels of the tournament are:

Hotel Casablanca Playa – Passeig de Miramar, 12, 43840 Salou

Hotel Olympus Palace – Av. Navarra, 6, 43840 Salou

Aparthotel Terra Aurea – Carrer de Ponent, 24, 43840 Salou

Participants who have booked their accommodation through the organization will enjoy free transport between the hotels and the sports hall, both before and after the competition each day. Transportation will also be provided during the training session on October 29 for all registered players.

Players staying in the official hotels may use the transport service together with their registered accompanying persons. The number of people entitled to use the transport will be indicated on the accreditation — one person for a single room, and two persons for a double room.

The transport service will operate throughout the day according to the official schedule, which will be published and displayed at each hotel and at the sports hall.

Transport will be provided by a van, so it is very important that all passengers queue at the stop.

The driver will take people in order of arrival at the stop.

If, at the scheduled departure time, there are still people waiting, the driver will return to pick them up after dropping off the first group.

If no one remains at the stop, the van will not return until the next scheduled trip.

#### Referees

During the group stage, players will be responsible for refereeing their matches.

For the final stages on the last two days of the tournament, volunteer referees and official umpires will be available to oversee all matches.

# **Award Ceremony**

B-Draw awards will be presented next to the table immediately after the final of each respective draw.

A-Draw awards will be presented during a formal award ceremony at the end of all finals.

All players receiving awards in the A-Draw must attend properly dressed in their official uniform.
